

Regular Maintenance

All Screenplay fabrics carry a W-Bleach cleaning code. It is important to vacuum upholstery regularly to remove the surface dust that builds up and slowly contributes to a graying effect that diminishes the clarity of the original color.

Cleaning Method Guidelines

Several light applications of a cleaning agent are less harmful than a single concentrated application; repeat stain treatment several times if necessary. Stains that do not respond to suggested hot water methods can be removed with a variety of water or solvent based cleaners. Do not oversaturate; excess moisture can leave a spot or ring. Residue from cleaners should be rinsed with hot clean water and blotted dry. Diluted bleach can be used on any stains which do not respond to other cleaning methods in a 4:1 dilution.

Remove Dried Solids

Hardened solids can be cleaned with a soft bristle brush to gently remove any loose particles without damaging the fabric. Do not use brush near seams. Use brush gently, avoiding a scrubbing motion, on textural surfaces to clean thoroughly between yarns.

Pretest

Pre-test any cleaning method recommended in the cleaning suggestions on an inconspicuous area of the fabric first to determine if the method will harm the fabric or adhesive bond to the wall.

Stain Removal Suggestions

In tests conducted at intervals of one hour, one day and seven days, 21 common stains were cleaned by the following procedures:

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| Adhesives | Wipe/brush with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Betadine | Wipe with a solution of liquid dish detergent and water. Then wipe with isopropyl alcohol. Towel dry. |
| Blood | Blot with a solution of cold water and liquid dish detergent. Then blot with ammonia solution. Rinse with water. Towel dry. |
| Butter | Wipe with a solution of cold water and liquid dish detergent. Towel dry. |
| Coffee | Wipe with hot water. Then apply all purpose cleaning solution. Towel dry. |
| Cola | Wipe with a solution of cold water and liquid dish detergent. Towel dry. |
| Crayon | Apply wax stripper. Rinse with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Hair Tonic | Wipe with a solution of cold water and liquid dish detergent. Towel dry. |
| Hairspray | Dab with liquid dish detergent solution. Then rinse with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Iodine | Wipe with a solution of cold water and liquid dish detergent. Then wipe with isopropyl alcohol. Towel dry. |
| Permanent Hair Dye | Wipe with a solution of cold water and liquid dish detergent. Then wipe with isopropyl alcohol. Towel dry. |
| Ketchup | Wipe with a solution of hot water and liquid dish detergent. Towel dry. |
| Liquid Soap | Wipe with hot water. Towel dry |
| Mustard | Wipe/brush with hot water. Then apply all purpose cleaning solution. Towel dry. |
| Nail Polish | Rub with nail polish remover. Then rinse with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Nail Polish Remover | Wipe with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Pen (ballpoint) | Wipe with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Salad Dressing | Wipe with a solution of hot water and liquid dish detergent. Towel dry. |
| Tea | Wipe with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Urine | Wipe with water-base spot remover. Wipe with vinegar. Rinse with hot water. Towel dry. |
| Wine | Wipe with hot water. Towel dry. |
