**STREET CHAIR** Inspired by the diverse culture and architecture of Barcelona, Spain, Josep Lluscà has designed a handsome, durable, easy-to-clean stacker for Spain's AMAT-3. The versatile Street armchair stacks six high for compact storage, can be used indoors or outdoors and is 100 percent recyclable. With a seat and back of stamped anodized aluminum, Street is the ideal complement to Jorge Pensi's café tables.

**JOSEP LLUSCÀ** One of Spain's most lauded industrial designers, Josep Lluscà is an artist and a teacher. A professor at the Escuela Eina of Barcelona, Lluscà's design innovations transcend the boundaries between science and art, with works that extend beyond furniture and into industrial applications such as lighting, applied electronics, toys and urban facilities. Very much an environmental designer, Lluscà has addressed the issue of practicality and art in public venues; his "Global Seating System" is known as one of the pioneering innovations in the area of public seating. He has received many prestigious accolades throughout his career, including the American Industrial Design Excellence Award and the National Design Award in Spain. His works are in the permanent collections of museums throughout the world.
