

Following is a summary of our environmentally sustainable products and practices.

Natural Fibers

- All Knoll Luxe patterns are made in whole or in part with natural fibers which are rapidly renewable.
- The cotton ground on Mohair Prima is certified organic.
- Galloway, Stirling and Garden City are made with 100% natural fiber with no added backings or finishes; they are therefore recyclable.

Human Safety

- All fabrics are Greenguard certified to ensure that they do not emit toxins in an interior.

Materials

- Brochures and sample tickets are made of FSC-certified, recycled paper.
- Fabric sample boxes are made of 100% acrylic, which is recyclable.

Third Party Certification

- The mill that produces Jaipur is ISO (International Standards Organization) 9000 certified, which ensures that a quality management program is in place. It also SA8000 certified; this is a global social accountability standard for decent working conditions.
- Lyon is certified by the international third party Oeko-Tex, which means that each ingredient in the fabric is evaluated and certified to be safe for human health. Mohair Prima is undergoing Oeko-Tex certification as well.
- The supplier for Mohair Prima ISO 14001 certified, an international quality control standard
- North Island is certified Enviromark Silver, a third party certification program in New Zealand that measures comprehensive environmental impacts.
