

# Knoll Luxe and Environmental Sustainability



Following is a summary of our environmentally sustainable products and practices.

## **Natural Fibers**

- Many Knoll Luxe patterns are made in whole or in part with natural fibers which are rapidly renewable.
- The cotton ground on Mohair Prima is certified organic.
- Arabella, Cummings, Galloway, Garden City, Gramercy, Mepal, Sandis, Stirling and Ravello are made with 100% natural fiber with no added backings or finishes.
- 9 additional fabrics in the Knoll Luxe line have 75%+ natural fiber.

## **Human Safety**

- All fabrics are Greenguard certified to ensure that they do not emit toxins in an interior.

## **Materials**

- Brochures and sample tickets are made of FSC-certified, recycled paper.
- Fabric sample boxes are made of 100% acrylic, which is recyclable.

## **Third Party Certification**

- The mill that produces Jaipur is ISO (International Standards Organization) 9000 certified, which ensures that a quality management program is in place. It also SA8000 certified; this is a global social accountability standard for decent working conditions.
- Mohair Prima is certified by the international third party Oeko-Tex, which means that each ingredient in the fabric is evaluated and certified to be safe for human health.
- North Island is certified Enviromark Diamond a third party certification program in New Zealand that measures comprehensive environmental impacts.
