Educated at the prestigious University of Design in Schwäebisch Gmüend, Markus Jehs and Jürgen Laub forged a friendship during New York internships that would become the foundation for a formidable design partnership spanning both industrial and interior design.

The Jehs+Laub Collection for KnollStudio reinterprets Knoll's pioneering introduction of sculptural furniture objects within an architectural context. The sweeping form of the Lounge Chair, featuring a streamlined profile and a composed, enveloping interior inspired by the traditional craft of quilting, is at ease in the workplace or home.

The Lounge Chair and Ottoman are refined and approachable, providing a subtle framework for repose. Featuring two distinctive base options, a polished aluminum swivel platform with optional return to center mechanism, or a dynamic polished chrome wire base, both bases are available with a black textured paint finish. Selection of a self welt or contrasting leather welt is a standard upholstery choice.
