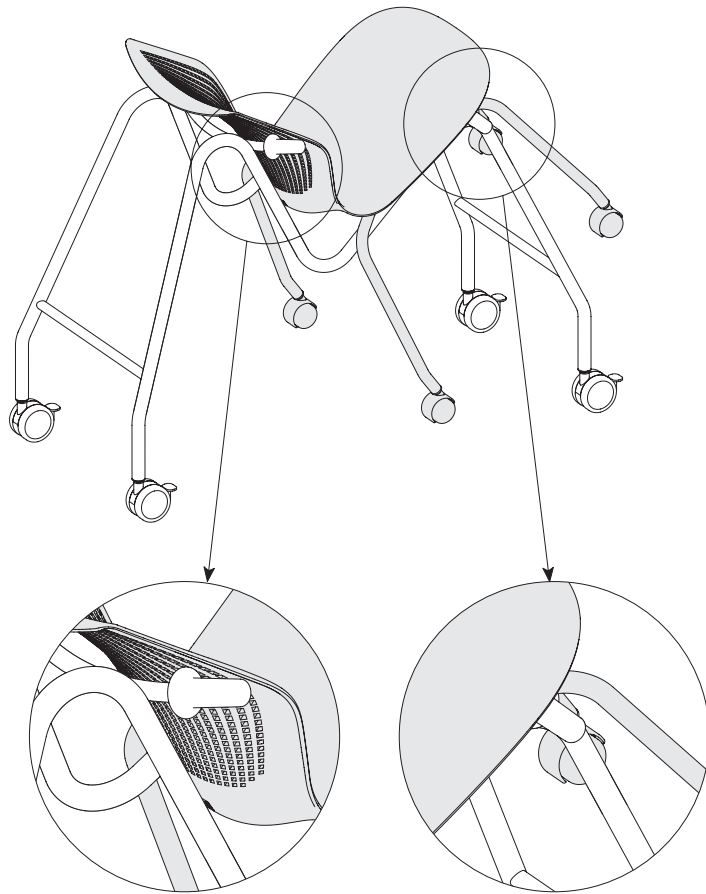


MultiGeneration Dolly Stacking Instructions

MultiGeneration by Knoll™

Chairs should not be stacked more than 10 units high on the dolly.

1. Position the MultiGeneration stacking chair with the seat surface facing upward.
2. On the dolly, there are two horizontal cross bars (one curved and one straight) that feature bumpers upon which the bottom chair will rest. Align the back of the chair with the curved cross bar and lower the chair until it rests centered on the bumpers. The legs of the chair will rest on the straight cross bar bumpers.
3. Continue stacking chairs centered on the bottom chair up to 10 units high.
4. The dolly features four locking casters. Push the tabs on the casters down to lock for secure stacking and storage. Pull the tabs up to release for transport.



Non-upholstered chairs

Non-upholstered stacking chairs feature bumpers to protect the seat finish of the chair below and prevent chairs from slipping. Do not stack non-upholstered chairs on upholstered chairs, as the bumpers can damage the seat upholstery of the chair below.

Upholstered chairs

Upholstered stacking chairs feature a stacking shield on the underside of the seat to protect the upholstery of the chair below. Do not stack upholstered chairs on non-upholstered chairs, as the stacking shield can damage the seat finish of the chair below.

The dolly stacked with 10 non-upholstered stacking chairs measures 53.5" high and with 10 upholstered seat stacking chairs, measures 55" high. The overall width is 19.7". The overall depth is 43.8".
