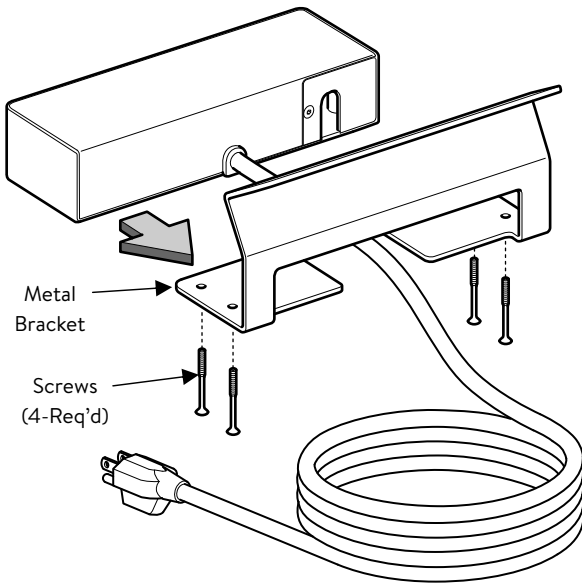

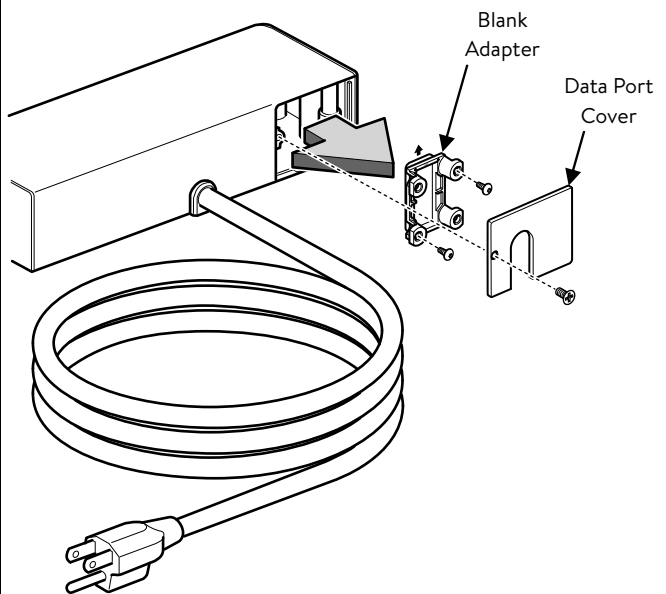

### 1 Remove Metal Bracket



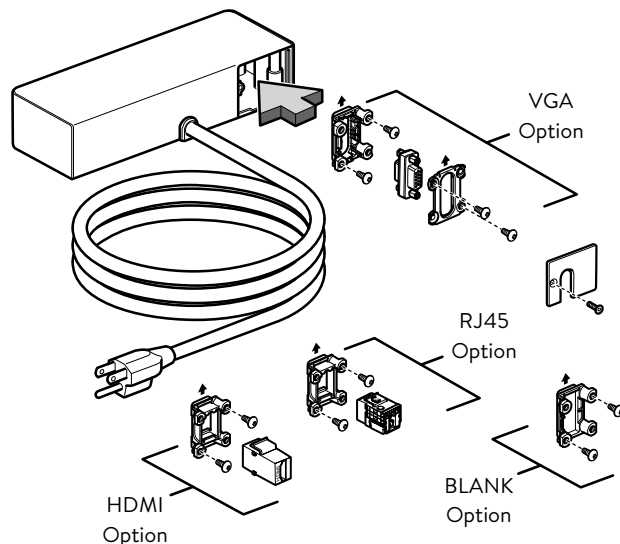
### 2 Remove Data Port Cover and Blank Adapter

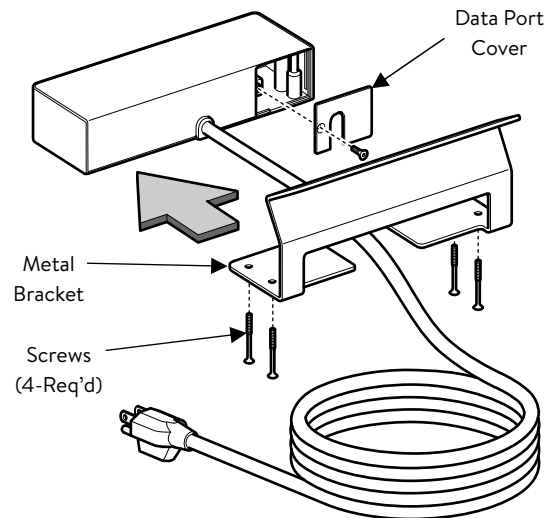

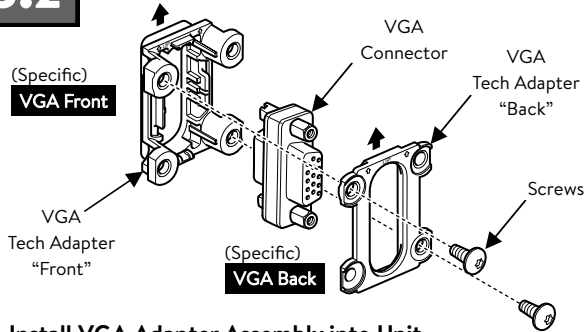

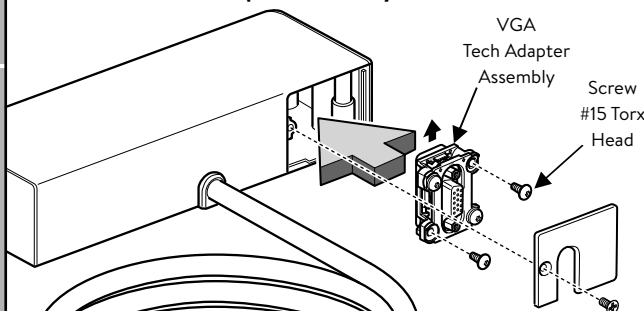

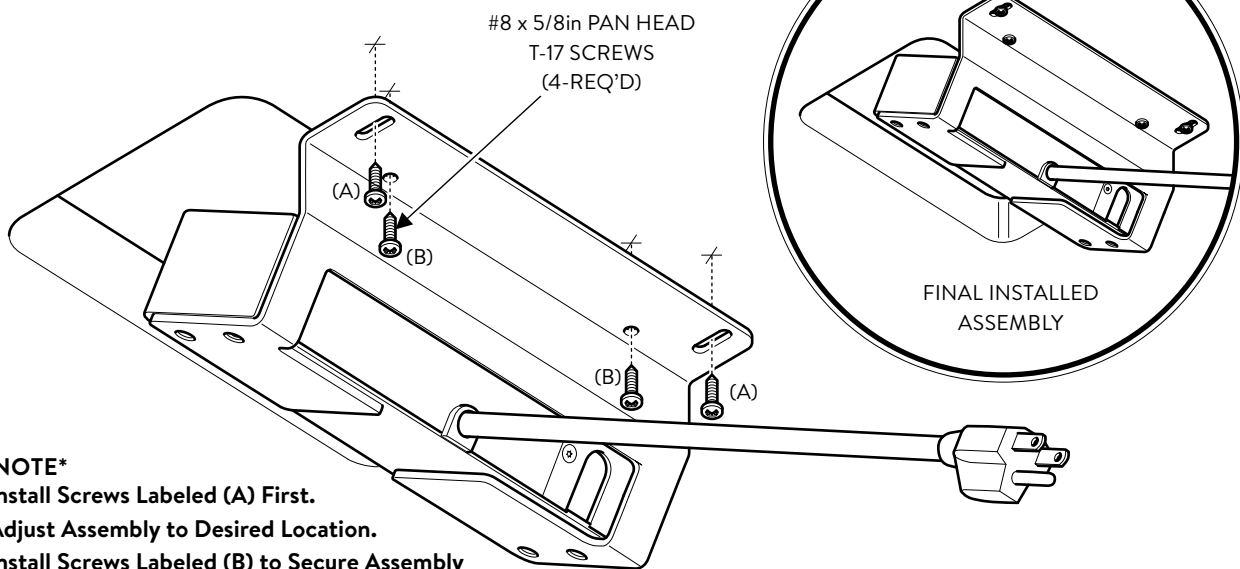


### 5 Table Power Center Outlet 311 Placement Dimensions
