### 2. Leg Surround



#### 2. Leg Surround Installation Instructions

- 2.1 Attach the fixed panel. (Fig 2)
  - 2.1.1. Attach the bumpers (1) as shown on all 4 corners (4x3=12 pcs).
  - 2.1.2. Attach the panel to the frame, using bracket (G) and screws (H).
- 2.2 Attach the removable panel. (Fig 3)
  - 2.2.1 Connect the duallock (J) in pairs and place them in all 4 corners (4x2=8 pcs).
  - 2.2.2 Attach the bumpers (I) as shown on all 4 corners sides (4x2=8 pcs).
- 2.3 Attach the grommet (K). (Fig 4)

## 3. Attach and Secure the Legs

- 3.1 Slide height adjustable leg through leg grommet. (Fig 5 and 6)
- 3.2 Attach foot to height adjustable leg using screws provided. (Fig 5 and 6)



- 4. Connect the Legs, Attach the Back, Shelf and Top Surface
- 4. Connect the legs, attach the back, shelf and top surface

(Fig 7)

- 4.1 Connect the legs and cross rails.Note: Refer to "Users Manual 6TP00004" available on Knoll Exchange.
- 4.2 Drop in place and secure the top surface.
- 4.3 Connect the wire manager.
- 4.4 Insert credenza back.
- 4.5 Lock the back in place with the fixed shelf.
- 4.6 Connect removable panel.
