Knoll Keyless Locking CPD Limitations and Capabilities

Due to the specific locking mechanisms and size of Digital Keypad and RFID locks, including applicable battery packs, not all Knoll products may accommodate keyless locks.

Anchor

Some Anchor products which do not offer standard keyless options may be available throught CPD. Examples include:

- + **Towers:** Anchor Towers may be engineered to accept keyless locks however, depending on Tower configuration, up to three individual locks may be required.
- Pedestals: Select doublewide pedestals without standard keyless lock option may be engineered to accept keyless locks but may require pull location or size to be altered.

Reff Profiles, 28-3/8" Planning

- + Overheads, cabinets, p edestals and credenzas with single hinged door may accommodate keyless locks.
- + Single drawer storage may accommodate keyless locks.

Rockwell Unscripted

+ Hinged door lockers may accommodate keyless locks.

Metal Storage: Calibre, Series 2, Template

Keyless locking may be accommodated many types of steel storage components including:

- + Lateral Files
- + Pedestals
- + Cabinets
- + Overhead Storage
- + Towers
- + Hybrids

All Digital Keypad and RFID locks used with Calibre, Series 2 or Template products are horizontal format locks with manual bolt. Automatic bolt cannot be accommodated.

Series 2 Template Steel or Laminate front is preferred for use with keyless locks. Calibre style or recessed pull style fronts may be possible to accommodate depending on order volume.

Calibre Lateral Files

- + Lateral file cabinets with individually locking drawers or with a single lock per cabinet can accommodate keyless locking in many situations.
- Individually locking drawers must be 6" high or larger to accommodate keyless locks.
- Individually locking file drawers utilize specialized hanging rail (included) to allow for Letter and Legal filing when using keyless locks.
- + Locks are centered horizontally on drawer face when using keyless locks with individually locking drawers.
- Locks are off-center within lock strip when using one keyless lock per cabinet.
- + Receding doors may not be locked with Digital Keypad or RFID locks.

Series 2 and Calibre Pedestals

- + Pedestals with individually locking drawers may accommodate keyless locks.
- Without individually locking drawers, lock will be centered in lock strip. Digital Keypad and RFID locks cannot be justified to the side.

Series 2 and Template Credenzas

+ Series 2 and Template credenzas with drawers may accommodate keyless locks.

Series 2 and Calibre Towers

 Towers may accommodate keyless locks. Depending on configuration, multiple locks per cabinet may be required.

Calibre Hybrids

 Hybrids may accommodate keyless locks. Multiple locks per cabinet would be required.

Volume requirements may apply depending on specific request.
