A NSF/ ANSI 3336 Facts Sustainability Certification indicates a textile has been evaluated for environmental, economic and social aspects across its life cycle. There are eight attributes considered as part of the rating: fiber sourcing (20%), safety of materials (30%), water conservation (6%), water quality (6%), energy (12%), air quality (2%), recycling practices (12%) and social accountability (12%).
