



Unpacking top and base cartons

1. The side table will arrive in two boxes: one for the top and one for the base.


Prepare your work area by spreading a clean blanket or towel over a hard flat surface. Open the top box beside your work area using scissors. Carefully remove top and place it on the blanket covered work area with the underside facing up. Then use scissors to open the base carton and remove the base, set aside.



Securing the threaded rod into the table top

1. Spin the nut onto the threaded rod. Pass the threaded rod through the lock washer, then through the flat washer. Screw the threaded rod into the insert on the underside of the table top. Hand tighten the threaded rod into the insert. Spin the nut down against the top, sandwiching the lock washer and the flat washer. Using a 13mm wrench, tighten the nut until it makes contact and then tighten an additional ¼ turn.


CAUTION: OVERTIGHTENING CAN CAUSE DAMAGE



Fastening the top and base together

1. Pick up the table base, slide the base with the narrow end facing downward onto the threaded rod in the table top. Slide the flat washer over the threaded rod and spin the nut on the threaded rod. Using a 13mm deep socket, tighten the nut until it makes contact and then tighten an additional ½ turn.

CAUTION: OVERTIGHTENING CAN CAUSE DAMAGE



Placement of side table

3. Place one hand on the edge of top while the other hand holds the stem of base. Carefully turn table right side up and place table on desired spot on floor.

CAUTION: NEVER MOVE THE TABLE BY THE TOP ONLY. ALWAYS MOVE THE TABLE BY THE STEM OF THE BASE WHILE SUPPORTING THE TOP WITH OTHER HAND.
